+ **must - positive**

I/You/He/She/It We/You/They	must	wash your hands.
--------------------------------	------	------------------

- **must - negative**

I/You/He/She/It We/You/They	mustn't must (not)	eat here.
--------------------------------	-----------------------	-----------

HAVE TO

+ **have to - positive**

I/You He/She/It We/You/They	have to has to have to	take off your belt.
-----------------------------------	------------------------------	------------------------

- **have to - positive**

I/You He/She/It We/You/They	don't doesn't don't	have to wear uniform.
-----------------------------------	---------------------------	--------------------------

CAN

+ **can - positive**

I You He/She/It We/You/They	can	run.
--------------------------------------	-----	------

- **can - negative**

I You He/She/It We/You/They	can't can (not)	run.
--------------------------------------	--------------------	------

? **have to - questions**

He has to wear a uniform.

Does he have to wear a uniform?

Do Does Do	I/you he/she/it we/they	have to wear uniform?
------------------	-------------------------------	--------------------------

- **mustn't/dont have to**

You mustn't talk after 9.30.

You don't have to go to sleep at 9.30.

have to - short answers

Yes, I/you/we/they	do.
Yes, he/she/it	does.

must/have to - Past simple

I must go.	} I had to go.
I have to go.	

? **must - questions and short answers**

He can run.

Can he run?

Can	I You He/She/It We/You/They	run?	Yes, ...can. No, ...can't.

TO BE GOING TO

+ **going to future - positive**

I You He/She/It We/You/They	'm 're 's 're	going to meet Bella.
--------------------------------------	------------------------	-------------------------

- **going to future - negative**

I You He/She/It We/You/They	'm not aren't isn't aren't	going to stay late.
--------------------------------------	-------------------------------------	------------------------

? **going to future - questions**

They are going to see a film.

Are they going to walk?
